WHY STUDY ACCOUNTING?

Accounting is a dynamic, creative and interesting subject. It is the process of gathering, recording, interpreting and analyzing financial information. Through a specialization in accounting at CBU, students learn the facts and figures that keep a business running. Commonly referred to as the language of business, accounting serves as the basis for financial decision-making.

By pursuing a specialization in accounting, students at CBU will gain an understanding of the global economy and develop an international perspective through various management, finance, and economic course assignments. The topics explored within the program include cash control, capital assets and cost behaviour to corporate investment, fiduciary accounting and foreign operations. Students graduate with the skills to confidently assist with decision making with the ability to analyze, compare and interpret business statements.

CO-OP INTERNSHIP OPTION

Students are eligible to take a paid internship while completing their BBA. The internship is usually 12-16 weeks in duration allowing students to work with a mentor in the field of study while earning a wage, three credits and a competitive edge when applying for future work.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

Students will take core BBA courses for the first two years of the program and then focus on accounting in year 3 and year 4 during their study period in Canada.

Students will receive a 4-year Canadian university degree upon the successful completion of the program.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants to the program must have completed five Grade 12 advanced or academic courses including English and Mathematics, with an overall average of at least 65%. Applicants must successfully complete the IELTS exam with a score of 6.5 band average with no individual section score less than 6.0.
